


“When mind is blank”

Blaise Pascal : A teenager and youth Scientists and Philosophers

The famous bachelor, is a radical inventor without whom we can't imagine the wholeness of mathematics and physics.

Mathematician Blaise Pascal was born on June 19, 1623, in Clermont-Ferrand, France. His mother passed away when Blaise was just an infant.

His father Etienne omitted mathematics from his son's early curriculum out of concern that Blaise would become so fascinated with geometry that he wouldn't be able to focus on classical subjects. The teen boy who took interest and learned geometry of himself. The inquisitive boy, who at the age of 12 began exploring geometry on his own. He made up his own terminology; not having learned official mathematical terms, and quickly managed to work out that the sum of a triangle's angles are equal to two right angles.

Blaise Pascal, a mathematical genius, at the age of 19 invented a machine, which he called the *Pascaline*, the first mechanised calculator, that could do addition and subtraction to help his father.

In the 1640s, while tinkering with barometric pressure, Blaise Pascal invented the syringe and the hydraulic press, which is widely used in medical science and hydraulic.

Without him the difficult topic like *probability* can never be understood. Originally *theory of probability* applied to gambling, today it is extremely important in economics, especially in actuarial science and analytics.

At the age of 39 he left his corporeal body to become an immortal. His last words being "May God never abandon me,". The scientist the strong believer of God and maintained celibacy, firmed in ethics, prefer to suffer, but never compromised with divinity.

He was highly religious, have strong faith on philosophy of good deed or misdeed and an ascetic bachelor. Besides math and physics, he had contributed equally in the field of religion, philosophy and literature. T. S. Eliot, British essayist, publisher, playwright and poet described him during this phase of his life as "a man of the world among ascetics, and an ascetic among men of the world."
